SMALL STATES SUMMER SCHOOL IN ICELAND JUNE 13 - JUNE 25, 2022



The Centre for Small State Studies at the University of Iceland offers a two-week intensive summer course, sponsored by an Erasmus+ grant, focusing on **Leadership in Small States**.

Small states face structural disadvantages related to their size in the international community. Clever diplomacy and powerful leadership are imperative in compensating for these disadvantages, not least for small states, as they are characterized by higher personalism than larger states.

- The 2022 Small State Summer School is organized by the Erasmus+ partnership "Leadership in Small States"
- The course brings together many of the leading scholars in the field of small state and leadership studies
- The course is open to Master's and Ph.D. students.
- Travel and accommodation is covered by the grant from Erasmus+.
- The course counts as 8 ECTS credits. Allocation of credits is in line with students' home university's rules and procedures.

Application process:

Students from the partner universities must apply directly through their own universities. Each partner university nominates up to three students to participate in the program based on a competitive selection process. Students can apply by sending a transcript and a motivational letter to their university's contact person.
